On 30 May 2010, a LOGOS team will run the legendary **Brussels half-marathon (20km)**! As always, this year's Brussels 20km is expected to be another wonderful occasion with a particularly festive atmosphere.

LOGOS has again decided to use this special opportunity to raise funds for **Constellations**, a charity that supports mentally handicapped persons in Brussels.

Not only are our staff running for this charity at the Brussels 20km, they are also donating money. In addition, LOGOS will match their contributions with the equivalent amount.

We would be honoured if you would help our efforts to support a specific new project – the building of a day centre and an accommodation centre in the Brussels region, where 40 mentally handicapped persons will be able to live autonomously.

Constellations in short

Constellations ASBL was created in 2001 by a group of parents and professionals, concerned about the future of mentally disabled children. They decided to act, after a study carried out in 1999 revealed a severe lack of caretaking facilities for mentally handicapped persons in the Brussels region.

The association aims to encourage and develop initiatives to create living spaces, services and activities for mentally handicapped persons, independent of their financial resources. *Constellations* is a non-profit organisation without political or religious affiliations, in accordance with its charter. Current Project: Building a new day centre and an accommodation centre in Brussels

Even though *Constellations* has successfully completed the first new accommodation facility in the Brussels region in ten years, which can house up to 10 adults with modest to severe mental disabilities, 20 more places are still needed in order to respond to the most urgent demands.

Therefore, the association has launched a new project, the creation of a day care facility and an accommodation facility, which will be able to house a further 20 persons.
